AGENDA ITEM 1 - APOLOGIES RECEIVED AND WELCOME

1.a Apologies received were as listed above. Eileen Donovan agreed to take Minutes in the absence of Mike Parkes.

AGENDA ITEM 2 – MINUTES AND MATTERS ARISING NOT TAKEN BELOW.

2. The Minutes of the previous meeting (18 March 2013) had been circulated in advance. Acceptance was proposed by Jane Brooksbank and agreed by the meeting unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM 3 – PROJECT PLAN PROGRESS

3.1 The Plan is now in Stage 3. It was explained that the next step immediately precedes the first statutory public consultation. A draft timetable of key steps between now and the submission of the Draft Plan in September was displayed and agreed.

3.2 The second draft of the Plan format recommended by NDP is available on the Forum website.

3.3 All CPs were requested to inform the Steering Group Chairman of any changes of Chair and Vice-Chair holders. Tracey Cabache reported that Cllr Pritchard had stood down as Chairman of Goodrington, Roselands and Hookhills CP but Christine Carter remained Vice Chairman and Cllr Alan Tyerman as Treasurer. Preston CP have yet to hold their AGM. There are no other CP changes.

3.4 The five CPs reported on their progress to-date.

- Blatchcombe CP – have discussed Blagdon Farm so far in the Western Area
- Clifton & Maidenway CP – are progressing discussion with potential volunteers
- Goodrington, Roselands & Hookhills CP – are intending to hold a meeting soon
- Paignton Town CP – have a shop for publicity that will open for 6 weeks from 20 May 13
- Preston CP – have met recently

3.5 Attention was drawn to the importance of meeting the criteria in the NPPF when presenting CP plans for consideration by the Forum, with particular reference to the balancing of housing need and supply based on objective assessment. It was agreed the next Steering Group meeting needs to discuss the CP inputs proposed.
